<p><b>SEALS – Scouts Excited About Leadership Skills</b>          48 max participants – Youth          Cost \$50  <b>Fri 6:30 pm – Sun 12:00 pm</b>  <i>See separate flyer for registration</i></p>	<p>Youth leadership course for boy scout youth leaders age 14 and under. Scouts are organized into patrols and learn leadership, communication, team work, problem solving, scout spirit and have a great time.</p>
<p><b>IOLS – Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills</b>          48 max participants - Adults          Cost \$25  <b>Fri 6:00 pm – Sun 12:00 pm</b>  <i>See separate flyer for registration</i></p>	<p>Participants are immersed in the Patrol Method in this hands-on training session. The goal of this course is to provide a working model of the boy-led troop learning many of the basic Scouting skills needed to attain the rank of First Class Scout. Adult leaders will experience skills instruction via the EDGE method in the context of a weekend campout with the troop, all wrapped up in plenty of Scout Spirit! This course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops and Varsity Scout Teams, in order to wear the Trained patch, and is prerequisite for Wood Badge.</p>
<p><b>Wilderness First Aid</b>          16 – max participants – Youth 14 and up – Adults          Cost - \$70 (American Red Cross Fee) – food will be supplied  <b>Fri 7:00pm – Sun 12:00pm</b>  <b>Must Register by April 15<sup>th</sup> – materials must be ordered</b></p>	<p>Wilderness First Aid is a two-day, 16 hour class designed for trip leaders, camp counselors, and outdoor enthusiasts. No previous experience is required. This emergency response training includes patient assessment, musculoskeletal and soft tissue injuries, splinting, and a variety of other topics. Meals will be supplied.</p>
<p><b>Certified Leave No Trace Trainer Course</b>          14 – max participants – Youth 16 and up / Adults          Cost \$45  <b>Sat. 8:00 am – Sun 3:00 pm</b></p>	<p>This LNT.org Certified two day course assists student participants in learning more about the seven principles of Leave No Trace, and techniques for disseminating these low impact skills. Successful graduates of the Trainer Course gain skills to teach Leave No Trace techniques and ethics to their clients, friends and family. Course is required for the Patrol LNT Trainer position and National Outdoor Award for Scouts.</p>
<p><b>Climbing Instructor Certification Training</b>          12 max participants – Adults          Cost \$65 (includes manual and t-shirt) – food will be supplied  <b>Fri @ 7:00 pm – Sun 2:00 pm</b></p>	<p>Climbing Instructor Certification is a 3 Day course designed to provide a working knowledge for running safe climbing events at the unit level. It would also allow you to serve as staff for any District or Council level climbing events. A great deal of information will be covered in a short period of time.</p>
<p><b>Cub Scout Day Camp Range Masters</b>          20 max participants – Adults          Cost: Free  <b>Sat 9:00am – 12:00pm</b></p>	<p>Course for leaders running (BB Gun and Archery) ranges during Cub Scout Day Camp and Camporees. Each participant will receive a Trained Card that is good for two years. The Minimum age is 18 years old to run a Range. Participants should park at the boat house at the upper lake and meet at the rifle range.</p>
