Dutch oven cook off: Please sign up when you check in for participation. Judging will be at 7:30pm sharp at the beginning of the campfire and this will be for desserts only.

Campfire Policy: No individual campfires will be allowed. We will have one site for our campfire program as we practice leave no trace. Grills and dutch oven tables will be allowed in your campsites. Ashes must be removed with you and not left behind. Leave no trace camping.

Food: There will be no onsite food service. All packs will have to supply, cook, and serve their packs at all meals. No fires will be allowed in camp. Only camp stoves, grills, and dutch oven tables may be used. Ashes cannot be dumped on site.

Trailers: If your pack has a trailer it will be allowed in the campsite but no other vehicles will be allowed in the campsites.

Water: We will have potable water in the form of a hose pipe on site. You will need to bring all water needs your pack has but the hose may be used to fill coolers with.

Trash: Pack it in. Pack it out. Leave no trace

Weather: As in any outside activity Mother Nature may like to play havoc on us. If rain is upon us camp will continue. If thunder and lightning are present camp will be closed and officially over.
