



# Have You Completed Your Required Leader Training?

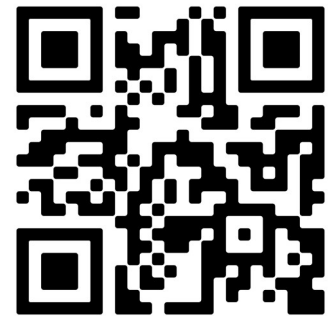

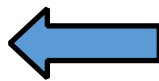
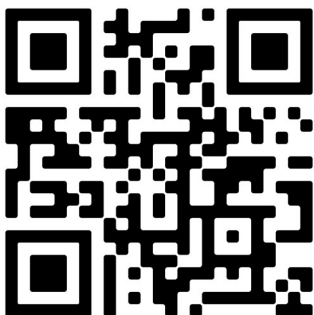

## Requirements

1. Training Chair Information **MUST** be recorded with the Council Office either through Unit Commissioner or the Google Form Below
2. All registered Volunteers must have completed their required training within 180 days of registration or recharter. This does not include Youth Protection (30 days)

Requirements are checked and award is given during the yearly District Awards Banquets

When a leader joins a unit, they get registered into a position in the unit. That might be a committee level position or a position that has more direct contact with the youth. Regardless of the position all registered leaders need to take Youth Protection Training within 30 days of registering. You can find that training at <https://www.scouting.org/training/youth-protection/>

In addition, you need to be trained for the position you are registered in. The Palmetto Council Executive Board voted in 2018 that all of our registered adult leaders must be 100% trained with the basic training for their registered position. That training is different if you are Den Leader, Committee Member, Asst Scoutmaster, etc. Most of the training is offered online through BSA's Online Learning Center. You can find the training for position by going to <https://www.scouting.org/training/adult/> and looking for leader specific training for the program you are registered in. (Cubs, Scouts BSA, Venturing, etc). We understand it can be a little overwhelming to know what to take and we are here to help.
